Employment and wages are based on completers found in Missouri wage records. Data are collected for employees eligible for Unemployment Insurance (UI), and exclude self-employment and independent contractors, military and federal employees, religious and other tax-exempt non-profit organizations, and certain other ineligible occupations. Missouri also participates in the [Census Bureau's Postsecondary Employment Outcomes project](#), which includes additional information on completers found working outside Missouri.

WIOA-approved programs will also again include information on approved certification regions. However, MoJobs remains the most current and official source for approved programs on the Eligible Training Provider List and should be used for WIOA program verification. MoSCORES may still lag a day or two in reflecting new programs and changes due to how and when data are migrated.

MoSCORES also includes additional listings of non-WIOA approved programs at colleges, universities, and other training providers, and can be a useful resource for those seeking educational and training opportunities in the state, regardless of funding source.
